Your estimated price is guaranteed not to change unless you order additional services and or add additional items to be moved which are not specifically listed on the estimate.** Please carefully review this estimate for accuracy. If you make any changes to the list of services ordered or the items to be moved, you must notify us prior to your move date so an updated estimate can be issued to avoid last minute price changes. Accuracy of your estimate is wholly dependent upon the specific items that you inform us of that you are moving. Any changes to your order will result in a change to your estimated price. If on the date of the move, you order last minute services or tender additional items to be moved the mover will issue you a new updated written estimate reflecting the change to the total estimated price. In such a case, a revised written visual estimate must be approved by you and signed prior to any services being performed. The Estimated Transportation Cost is BINDING based on the total Cu Ft (Volume Amount) provided by customer prior to move date. This document is an estimate only and is not a contract. Packing labor and materials are not included unless specifically itemized on the estimate. Customer Responsibility is to make sure that all boxes and fragile items are properly protected, packed, boxed up and ready for pick-up unless noted differently on this Binding Estimate Cost for Service. This estimate covers only the articles and services specifically listed.

This Binding Estimate includes the following:

- * Professional Door to Door service.
- * Expert advice and guidance throughout the course of your move.
- * Disassembly of all standard furniture required for safe movement at the origin.
- * Reassembly for all items at destination that were disassembled by the movers on pick-up.
- * Wrapping of all furniture with quilted moving blankets.
- * Itemized inventory indicating condition of items at origin.
- * Loading and unloading of all goods.
- * All transportation, taxes, tolls, mileage, and fuel surcharges.
- * Standard cargo protection up to \$10,000 based on 0.60 cents per lb. per article.

The inventory provided by you on this Binding Estimate Cost for Service is only used as a tool for the carrier to generate your total cubic feet (Volume Amount). The inventory items listed below create an estimated volume to base the estimate of service cost (cubic footage is not guaranteed to be accurate. Any additional cubic footage or any additional services added on move-out day will result in an additional cost based on the terms the Binding Estimate. This estimate includes labor, loading, unloading, and basic valuation. All items being shipped must be properly packed or they will not be moved.

Optional Additional Services and Additional fees (if applicable to the move):

It is customary for Trinity Van Lines and or its Agents to offer additional service options to the customer. Optional services include, but are not limited to, storage, packing, materials, unpacking, appliance servicing, shuttle, long carry, rigging hoisting and lowering, wooden crating, exclusive use of vehicle, guaranteed delivery, etc. If you order an additional service or an additional service is required to complete the move, then the charge for the service will be added to the final bill.

- Long carry: Each 50 ft. \$100.00
- Shuttle service: \$1.00 per cu.ft. (\$700 minimum)
- Packing of fragile/delicate items (such as TVs, glass, etc.); packing and crating services not already listed within proposal; loading of bulky items (such as a motorcycle).
- Packing labor and supplies such as boxes, bubble wrap, etc.
- Storage: any additional month will be charged at \$50.00 per 100 cu.ft. per month.

COMPANY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS OF PAYMENTS: Upon reservation, a deposit and an admin/booking/origin fee, is required to be paid in the form of check by phone, wire transfer, Zelle, or a Bank teller deposit. This initial payment is to reserve your space/labor/supplies, etc on our schedule.

Prior to pick up: 50% of the balance is due in the form of money order, check by phone, wire transfer, certified check or cash. At delivery, the balance is due prior to unloading in the form of Post Office Money Order or cash. Trinity Van Lines or it's Agent Carrier reserves the right to collect up to 70% of balance due prior to the goods leaving the origin state. Subject to federal law, payment in FULL of all charges is required before delivery and prior to unloading.

PACKING YOUR GOODS: All Customers are responsible to pack all boxes and fragile items (glass, mirror, marble, and electronics) unless noted differently on this Estimate. For health and sanitary reasons all mattress', box springs, and futon pads must be properly protected in a Mattress box or plastic covers. Personal effects in plastic bags are not allowed in the truck. Packing supplies are not included in the transportation cost and will be charged if required. Elaborate furniture items that need to be disassembled and/or reassembled may require a 3rd party professional servicing or additional labor and should be disclosed to your estimator in advance of the move to be included on the estimate. Disconnecting and reconnecting of appliances is not included in the estimate. Reassembly of any item is subject to the availability of tools and/or parts being available at delivery. Packing, materials, and/or unpacking services are available at an additional charge and are only included in this estimate if the service is listed on the services section of the estimate.

ABBREVIATIONS: Articles listed as follows: Articles listed as CP = Carrier Packed; PBO = Packed By Owner; PO = fragile item to be wrapped with Pads Only per customer.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE: Some buildings require a certificate of insurance from the mover. Please check with your building management at both current and new locations regarding their requirements. Please notify your Relocation Specialist and we will be glad to assist you. Note: A fee may apply depending on building requirements.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS: Customers must confirm parking restrictions with the building's management or local police department at both current and new locations for the carrier to avoid parking violations. If the truck physically or for reasons of parking restrictions cannot park close enough, Long Carrying or Shuttle Truck Service charges will apply and added to the original agreement.

FURNITURE TRANSPORTATION: Our Company requires that all drawers must be emptied prior to the day of move. Furniture with full drawers will not be transported due to high risk of damage to the actual furniture, premises walls and floors, and/or injury to personnel.

UTILITIES/APPLIANCES: Make sure that all of your utilities and appliances will be turned off and disassembled from electric, gas and water connections, TV's removed from walls, prior to the day of your move. We do not disassemble or reassemble any utilities or appliances at both current and new locations on the day of your move-out or move-in.

LIABILITY: Trinity Van Lines and or its Agents provides two valuation options: Limited liability and full replacement value (FVP). Both plans cover furniture and boxes packed/unpacked by the carrier. We suggest you purchase third party insurance to protect your property. Please read carefully before making your selection. Subject to the minimum valuation of \$0.60 per pound per article and in compliance with and subject to the provisions of 49 CFR Section 375.701(a), Trinity Van Lines cannot control whether proper packing methods are used by shipper, therefore on boxes packed by the owner as well as pressed wood (particle board) furniture, fragile or brittle items such as glass, china, ornaments, etc.; liability is limited to \$0.60 per pound per article. The carrier has the right to inspect and repair any alleged damages. Consumer/shipper waives all claims and Trinity Van Lines or it's agents are not liable or

negligent for any damages to the interior or exterior of any residences including, but not limited to walls, floors, ceilings, stairs, banisters, carpets, plumbing, doorways, driveways, walkways, landscaping, etc. In addition, you are not able to give to us to carry and we accept no liability whatsoever for firearms, jewelry, cash, bank notes, any financial instruments, hazardous materials nor liquids.

PICK UP AND DELIVERY SCHEDULE: ALL PICKUP AND DELIVERY DATES ARE ESTIMATES AND ARE NOT GUARANTEED UNLESS PREMIUM GUARANTEED SERVICE (P.G.S.) IS PURCHASED and specifically defined in a line item on this Binding Estimate. Standard Service (SS) Pick-Up Dates and Standard Service Delivery Dates are estimates. Standard Service (S.S.) delivery time frame is up to a maximum of thirty business weekdays, not including storage time, beginning on the First Available Date of Delivery (FADD) (not the date of pickup). Trinity Van Lines and or its agents estimated delivery period is up to thirty business days from the date indicated as first available for delivery. All Estimated time of arrivals are subject to change depending on many industry factors such as Acts of God, Acts of Nature, traffic, weather conditions, unforeseen mechanical problems, unforeseen Crew issues or unexpected services to be rendered with orders scheduled before or after your delivery, etc.... Note: Trinity Van Lines nor its agents will not discount any account due to any delays listed above. We will keep the you informed of changes to pick-up and delivery schedules, to the best of our ability throughout the move process as our schedule allows.

*** Trinity Van Lines and or its agents will not discount any account due to any delays in Estimated Pick-up or Delivery times.

REVISED WRITTEN BINDING ESTIMATE COST FOR SERVICE: This Binding Estimate is made in advance with you the client to provide a discounted rate with an estimated size of your move. The Carrier has accepted this Binding Estimate as their own. If, when the Carrier arrives onsite, before loading your household goods, the Carriers foreman believes that the estimated size of the items you wish to move is not accurate and that you have additional household goods to be moved and or that you require additional services not identified in the initial Binding Estimate. Trinity Van lines and or its Agent will agree to negotiate a revised written Binding Estimate which will list the additional cubic feet of household goods and/or additional services needed. By executing a new Binding Estimate, the carrier and the customer will consider the initial Binding Estimate null and void and that it will no longer control the move. If you and the carrier cannot reach an agreement, you retain the right to Cancel your move and the carrier retains the right to refuse to service the additional household goods or services.

AGENTS: TRINITY VAN LINES IS A PROPERLY LICENSED INTERSTATE MOVING BROKER WHO WILL COORDINATE, ARRANGE AND TRANSFER THIS BINDING ESTIMATE TO THE CARRIER AGENT FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS BY AN FMCSA AUTHORIZED MOTOR CARRIER AGENT AS PER THIS BINDING ESTIMATE. UPON TRANSFER THE CARRIER WILL TREAT THIS BINDING ESTIMATE AS THEIR OWN. THE CARRIERS CHARGES ARE DETERMINED BY ITS PUBLISHED TARIFF. ALL ESTIMATED CHARGES AND FINAL ACTUAL CHARGES ARE BASED UPON THE CARRIER'S TARIFF WHICH IS AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION FROM THE CARRIER UPON REASONABLE REQUEST. TRINITY VAN LINES PROVIDES ADMINISTRATION, LOGISTICS, CUSTOMER SERVICE AND ADVOCATES ON BEHALF OF THE CLIENT TO SERVICE THE CLIENT. TRINITY VAN LINES DOES NOT PACK, PICK-UP, TRANSPORT, DELIVER OR INSURE A CUSTOMER'S HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND THEREFORE IS NOT LIABLE AND CANNOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF ANY OF THOSE ITEMS. Additionally, unless you purchased an exclusive use of the Vehicle Option, it is standard practice for items to be or offloaded, temporarily stored, consolidated with other shipments and reloaded onto a different vehicle than the one that performed the pickup.

LEGAL PROCESS NOTICE TO ALL CLAIMS: Trinity Van Lines is not liable and shall not be held liable for the loss or damage of the goods transported. A claim for any loss or damage of goods must be made in writing to the Carrier as per Carrier's requirements, supported by proof of ownership, value, and weight. As a condition precedent, all outstanding monies due to Trinity Van Lines and the Carrier must be paid in full before any claim can be made. Claims must be filed with the assigned Carrier within 9 months of delivery or demand thereof is refused and must be limited to the destination descriptions of damages for each item on the inventory logs. All damages and missing items must be noted on the inventory logs. Damage indications must specify each item damaged at the time of delivery.

JURISDICTION, VENUE AND CONTROLLING LAW: The customer/shipper consents to the jurisdiction and the venue of any court of general jurisdiction of Broward County, Florida and any legal proceedings arising out of this agreement shall be brought only in Broward County, FL courts. In the event customer/shipper institutes legal proceedings in any court other than in Broward County, FL the customer/shipper shall assume all Trinity Van Lines costs in connection therewith, including but not limited to reasonable: administrative time, travel time, travel costs, attorneys fees, court costs and collection fees. The parties acknowledge that Trinity Van Lines has customers all over the United States and cannot subject itself to jurisdiction throughout the country. All parties agree that Florida is a reasonable and appropriate jurisdiction for the resolution of any disputes arising out of this agreement.

SUMMARY OF DISPUTE SETTLEMENT PROGRAM: The neutral arbitration program has been designed to give neither party any special advantage. If a dispute arises between Trinity Van Lines, Inc. or its agents and the shipper, arbitration may be a mutually beneficial alternative to help resolve the dispute. Section 49 CFR Section 375.211 provides that a mover must have a program in place to provide shippers with an Arbitration alternative. Arbitration is optional and not required under Federal law. A. Summary of the arbitration process: Arbitration is an alternative to courtroom litigation. It provides each party to the dispute to present their cases and allows a neutral third-party arbitrator to make decision as to the merits of each sides case. Arbitration subject to this agreement shall be conducted via written submission and, subject to the arbitrator's discretion, through telephonic appearance. After the initial filing fees have been paid and the arbitrator selected, the initiating party or Claimant must submit a written brief summarizing their legal position and factual claims. All supporting documentation must be included with the initial arbitration brief. Copies of all documents must be submitted to all parties involved in the arbitration. Upon receipt of the Claimant's arbitration brief and supporting documents, the responding party or Respondent will have 30 days to file their responsive arbitration brief and supporting documentation. Further deadlines and timetables are subject to the arbitrator's discretion. B. Legal effects: If the arbitration alternative is chosen, then any decision made by the arbitrator may be binding. Additionally, an arbitration decision may not be appealed in a court of law. All parties agree

that the Arbitrators decision will be based exclusively on the governing United States Federal Law without regard to conflicting State laws or regulations. C. Applicable costs: Each party is responsible for their own costs associated with arbitration. A benefit to the arbitration alternative may be that it is less expensive than traditional litigation. Each party is responsible for 50% of the costs associated with securing the arbitrator and 100% of their own expenses, including but not limited to attorney fees. There is a \$250 filing fee FOR EACH PARTY and a supplemental charge of \$50 administration fee. Call carrier at phone number on front of this form for ADR processing forms.

RECORDED PHONE CALLS: Telephone calls with Trinity Van Lines are routinely recorded for quality assurance. All recordings are the expressed property of Trinity Van Lines and will not be released to customers except pursuant to a lawful court order or when Trinity Van Lines deems appropriate, in its sole discretion, to resolve a dispute.

SHIPMENT VALUATION AND COVERAGE: Trinity Van Lines is not liable for loss or damage to the Customers transported items. If any article is lost, damaged or destroyed while in the Carrier's custody, the Carrier's liability is limited to the actual weight of the lost, destroyed or damaged article multiplied by \$0.60 cent per pound per article. This is the basic liability level and is provided to you at no charge. It is considerably less than the average value of most household goods. Full value protection coverage is available for additional cost at customer's request (cannot be purchased after move has begun). See "Full Value Protection Amount of Liability" above.

NOTICE OF MAXIMUM AMOUNT DUE UPON DELIVERY: Final charges will be based on actual volume (cu ft) of property and services provided. Maximum amount demanded at time of delivery, prior to unloading, is 100% of the last signed Binding Estimate. Actual charges may exceed the amount of estimate only if additional services were ordered or required to be performed or if additional storage was necessary.

VERY IMPORTANT - IF YOU ADD ITEMS AT PICK-UP OR IF THE ITEMS TO BE PICKED UP ARE OF A DIFFERENT VOLUME FROM WHAT IS ITEMIZED ON THIS ESTIMATE OR YOU ADD SERVICES:

- The Carrier's foreman may provide you with a revised written Binding Estimate including additional inventory or services needed. The new Binding Estimate must be agreed to by you and the foreman prior to the move commencing.
- DO NOT allow the mover to load the truck or perform any services before you have agreed in writing to the new Binding Estimate
- If you have not signed the mover's revised Binding Estimate and the mover loads the truck, then Federal regulation requires that the mover has reaffirmed the original Binding Estimate and cannot demand additional payment at delivery for the additional items. Any balance due above the Binding Estimate would need to be billed by the mover thirty days after delivery.
- We advise you to notify us of any and all modifications to your Binding Estimate at least 5 business days prior to the first scheduled pick-up date to avoid changes upon pick-up. On the day of pick-up, your foreman will compare the estimated inventory to the inventory actually being moved. If there are no changes between the actual service needed and the Binding Estimate, the total price will be the same as the price listed on this Binding Estimate.
- If there are additional services or changes in inventory needed, the foreman will explain the changes and provide a new revised written Binding Estimate listing all costs for the actual entire move including the additional services ordered or additional items to be moved.

CLAIM FILING PROCEDURE: If you realize that some of your goods are damaged or missing, or if you feel that you have been over-charged or charged for services that you didn't receive prior, during or after services were completed, you agree that you MUST initially give Trinity Van Lines and or its Agents the FIRST RIGHT to fully investigate and respond in writing with a resolution to your issues.

To initiate a Service Investigation please notify our Customer Service Department at info@trinitymoving.net. In the event you are not satisfied when a resolution is made to your claim/complaint, ONLY THEN you may contact any state, city, government, insurance, and consumer group such as a public media organization, internet website, bank or credit card agency.

NOTICE AND WAIVERS: In accordance with 49 CFR § 375.401(a)(2) and 49 CFR §371.113(c)(1), customer agrees to waive a physical survey in-home estimate of the household goods and alternatively agrees to receive a non-physical survey based on the Binding Estimate which was based on the information the customer provided concerning the itemized list of property to be transported and other services ordered. The Customer has agreed to receive and subsequently review the FMCSA publications “Ready to Move? – Tips for a Successful Interstate Move” and “Your Rights and Responsibilities When you Move” via hyperlink below and accessed the Federal consumer protection information in the Internet.” The terms of this estimate and all services to be provided are subject to the carrier's tariffs, incorporated by reference and available for inspection upon reasonable request at the carrier's offices.
