PRINT YOUR INVENTORY	Tape it to your Fridge/Common Area. As you Pack, check off the items your bringing, Scratch off things you are not, and notate the things you forgot/decided to bring.
PLAN YOUR TRIP	Preparing for the Jourey -Map out travel times, resources needed, and the things you will need while your goods are in transit.
1 WEEK BEFORE MOVE	Prepare your Home and Appliances
MOVE OUT DATE & TIME	MOVE IN DATE & TIME
TRANSFER SERVICES	With the Packing and Planning Completed (or close to), keep in mind that you will need to update Your Services to the new address

At Pick Up - During Move	Mover will do a walk through, provide updated paperwork and receipt for payment. Let them Work	ANY Chance in price CALL US BEFORE the Mover Start
At Delivery - Move Done	Movers will unload, re-asemble and stage. Take Final payment and provide you Receipt	Make sure Everything is there & in Good Condition

<input type="checkbox"/> Unplug, empty out, defrost, wipe down and open the doors of your freezer, ice maker and refrigerator at least 24 hours before your movers are set to arrive	
<input type="checkbox"/> Disassemble your water filtration system	<input type="checkbox"/> Empty dishwasher and let it air out, so there is no moisture inside.
<input type="checkbox"/> Disconnect and disassemble/stabilize your washer and dryer	<input type="checkbox"/> Remove/return any propane canisters
<input type="checkbox"/> Pack up any smaller appliances, like your microwave, air fryer, crock pots and pressure cookers. Make sure to pad boxes with material to avoid damage	
<input type="checkbox"/> make sure that there is no oil or gas inside any grills, lawn mowers and/or other gas-powered items	
<input type="checkbox"/> Disassemble garden hoses and lawn care equipment and allow sufficient time for them to dry out.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Remove light bulbs from lamps and lighting fixtures and pack those securely with lots of padding to avoid breakage.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Disassemble televisions and mounting systems	

- ☐ Plan your route, hotels, places to stop to eat, gas fill-ups and attractions
- ☐ Prepare clothes, toiletries, snacks, electronics and other items you might need for your travels to your new home.
- ☐ Be aware of the weather for the week of your trip
- ☐ Pack important things personal documents, photographs and portable valuables, like electronics and jewelry, separate from items to be loaded onto a moving truck.
- ☐ Service your vehicle/s if you are driving to your destination, including oil change/s. Make sure you fill your gas tank as well or Make your travel arrangements if you're not driving
- ☐ Call your movers to confirm details if you are shipping your car to your new destination
